There are four types of grants:

Applications are open to **postgraduates** who have obtained a master degree (including master thesis) or a doctoral degree (or equivalent degree) in various fields (including e.g. Natural Sciences, Technical Sciences, Human Medicine, Health Sciences, Agricultural Sciences, Social Sciences, Humanities and Arts) as well as to **graduates** in the field of music (only).

→ Post-doc Grants (research grants)

Duration: 3 – 9 months (new!)

Grant benefit approximately: >1,150 euros

→ PhD-Grants

Grant for a complete PhD programme in Austria

Duration: 36 months

Grant benefit approximately: >1,050 euros

→ Sandwich-Grants

Grant for a partial study period during a PhD programme in Austria

Duration: 9 months (new!)

Grant benefit approximately: >1,050 euros

→ Music-Grants

Duration: max. 9 months

Grant benefit approximately: >1,050 euros

Additionally, scholarship holders receive a travel cost subsidy of max. 730 euros.

Maximum age:

Graduates and postgraduates: 35 years

Post docs: 45 years

Very good knowledge of English and/or German

March 31st, 2018
